What: **Novice** (8:00 to 10:00) Emphasizing obstacle patterns that are typically encountered at the Novice level and preparing teams for Novice competition.

Novice (10:30 to 12:30) Emphasizing obstacle patterns that are typically encountered at the Novice level and preparing teams for Novice competition.

Open/Excellent (1:00 to 3:00) Emphasizing obstacle patterns that are typically encountered at the Open and Excellent levels and preparing teams for competition.

Fun Run (4:00 to 6:00) Hosting two rings, one standard and one JWW. Workshop participants receive two fun run vouchers for free. Advanced registration required. Entries are limited.

Location: Doyle Elementary School is a completely fenced in grass field. There are large shade trees and running water. The restrooms are a good walk away. Parking is plentiful and close. No RVs.

Directions: From Interstate 5 north or south – Exit at La Jolla Village Drive, Go East on La Jolla Village Drive 0.7 mile, Turn right at Regents Road 0.6 mile, Turn left at Berino Court and proceed straight into the school parking lot, Turn right towards the school's athletic field.

Eligibility: All dogs must be under control. They must be at least a year old, vaccinated, and healthy. They must have basic obedience skills of sit, down, stay and come when called. They must be able to work around other people and dogs. Additional pre-requisites are listed for each class below.

Arrival time: Arriving on time is very important. You are encouraged to arrive no less than 15 minutes prior to your class start time. *Do not come more than 30 minutes before class.* This will give you time to set up and familiarize yourself and the dog to the new surroundings.

Workshop format: We will be doing AKC style course work. We start with short jumpers drills. These drills will incorporate level appropriate challenges, increasing in difficulty with each drill, and ending with distance work. Following the drills, we will be doing standard course work. Each course is broken down into workable parts. After training on each subsection, we connect them with a full course run through. The class is limited to six teams. This allows ample time for everyone. We work at a fast pace. Please sign up for the appropriate level.

Novice Class: We will work on obstacle patterns that are typically encountered at the Novice level. This class is designed to prepare teams for Novice competition. Sequences are presented to encourage working independence, and a flowing handling style. Positioning strategies are emphasized as well as the basic skills like contact performance, front and rear crosses, and start line options.

Pre-requisites: The dog should:

1. Be working on full or near full height contact equipment.
2. Be able to reliably do a set of six weave poles.
3. Be able to perform multiple obstacles in succession.

Open / Excellent Class: We will work on obstacle patterns that are typically encountered at the Open and Excellent levels, and in preparing teams for competition. Sequences are presented to challenge existing skills and build new ones. Handling strategies and basic skills are reviewed like contact performance, front and rear crosses, and start lines. Additionally, higher level competency will be required to successfully negotiate the drills, discriminations, distance, and difficult approach angles.

Pre-requisites: The dog should:

1. Be working on full height contact equipment.
2. Be able to reliably do a set of twelve weave poles.
3. Have at least one qualifying score in AKC Open Level, or equivalent.

Fun Run: Whether you are participating in the workshop or just doing the fun run, you must fill out a registration form. The fun run will feature two rings, each at approximately 80' x 80'. One ring will feature a Standard course and the other, a Jumpers with Weaves course. This is a limited entry fun run. All workshop participants receive two free runs. A team should be able to complete 4 runs during the two hour period. All teams doing the fun run must meet eligibility and novice pre-requisites. You may use treats in the ring. Toys are allowed. Special training aids are okay, like a target plate, stride regulator, providing they do not take too much time.

What to bring: Bring training materials including plenty of treats, the dog's favorite toys, and a leash. Bring a canopy for shade, a chair and a crate for your dog's security. Bring water and snacks for yourself. Bring bags to clean up with.
